How **Auckland** compares with the **rest of New Zealand**

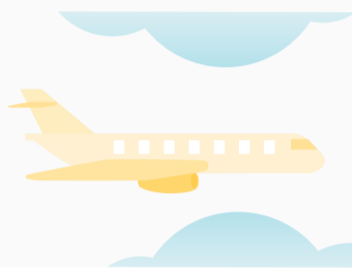
European	<b>59%</b>	vs	<b>81%</b>

## Auckland is the destination of choice

**75.2%** in full-time employment

**18.7%** in part-time employment

**6.2%** unemployed

## Perceptions of housing quality: 2014



**60%**

said their house or flat needs repairs or maintenance



**48%**

said their house or flat is colder than they would like



**32%**

said they have a problem with dampness or mould

## Proportion of household income spent on housing costs: 2014/15

How **Auckland** compares with the **rest of New Zealand**

**18.8%** vs **14.4%**



## Aucklanders have similar levels of well-being as the rest of New Zealand



### Overall life satisfaction: 2014

**83%** of Aucklanders rated their overall life satisfaction as 7–10 (on a scale of 0–10)



### Loneliness: 2014

**65%** of Aucklanders did not feel lonely in the last four weeks



### General health status: 2014

**88%** of Aucklanders said their health was good, very good, or excellent



### Disability: 2013

**19%** of Aucklanders are disabled. This is lower than the national rate of 23%\*
